SCHOOLS

Expanded and built new Welsh Medium Schools, and promoted the benefits of bilingualism, achieving a record uptake in Welsh Medium Education, with the ambition to keep expanding, in support of Welsh Government's 1 million Welsh Speakers vision.



20 MPH

Progressed our plans to make 20 mph the default speed in residential areas of Cardiff, with the measure now applied to huge swathes of the city. Parts of Cardiff North are the latest area going through the process, as part of a Welsh Government pilot to make 20 mph the residential default across Wales.



ONE PLANET

Declared a Climate Emergency, followed up by a strategy and action plan – One Planet Cardiff – for a Carbon Neutral Cardiff by 2030. Projects that we've delivered so far have helped reduce the Council's direction Cardiff footprint by 17% every year since 2017.

LED LIGHTS

Expanded the roll-out of LED streetlights, with 14,000 installed on main highways, and an ongoing programme to install 23,000 in residential streets. These lights are better for the environment, easier to maintain and saves the Council hundreds of thousands in electricity bills.

UPDATE - LYDSTEP FLATS BLOCK 1, 2 and 3

We are pleased to inform you that the scheme to overclad work has begun on the three blocks at Lydstep Flats. The Council's appointed contractor is ISG Ltd and the project duration will be approximately 70 weeks to complete all 3 blocks. Firstly, the contractor will set up their site compound, which will run parallel to Lydstep Crescent on the grassed area. The project will see the new A1 rated cladding fitted, this cladding is of the highest level of fire safety. New windows, balcony upgrades including balustrading, surfacing and a new balcony door will also be fitted. Each property will also benefit from a new extract ventilation system for the kitchen, bathroom and also have a new flue fitted to the boiler. Your Llandaff North Labour team have tirelessly campaigned with the Cabinet Member to deliver this for all the residents of Lydstep Flats

UPDATE ON THE LEVEL CROSSING - FOOTBRIDGE



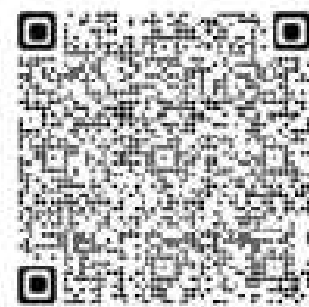
Transport for Wales is planning to replace the level crossing near Llandaf station with a footbridge in the same location. With the electrification of the railway, trains will become quieter and more frequent, so level crossings will become increasingly dangerous for pedestrians. We are aware of concern about the lack of consultation from Transport for Wales on its plans, so we have been working with Julie Morgan MS and Anna McMorrin MP to ensure that residents' voices are being heard. On February 18 we attended a Zoom meeting arranged by Julie and Anna which allowed residents to directly ask questions to Transport for Wales on its plans for the bridge. We know there are still concerns about how the bridge will affect the Llandaff North allotments, so we will work closely with Julie, Anna and Transport for Wales to ensure that there is as minimal disruption and environmental impact as possible. Transport for Wales has held a community drop-in session with residents to show the proposed designs of the footbridge.

UPDATE - PUMPING STATION AT HAILEY PARK



Councillors received a petition from the chair of LNRA, Stephanie Wilkins against the Hailey Park pumping station. We forwarded the petition to the planning committee, however the petition was not valid.

The petitioner has submitted a new petition to the planning committee. Councillors are in support of the petition and will attend the planning committee when the item comes for consideration in April (TBC). For more information on Welsh Water's proposed planning application, scan the QR code.
