

Achievements over the last 5 years:

- **Lydstep Flats, Block 1, 2 and 3:** Overcladding work has begun at Lydstep Flats. The project will see the new A1 rated cladding fitted; this cladding is of the highest level of fire safety. New windows, balcony upgrades including balustrading, surfacing and a new balcony door will also be fitted. Each property will also benefit from a new extract ventilation system for the kitchen, bathroom and have a new flue fitted to the boiler.
- **Ysgol Glan Ceubal and Gabalfa Primary:** Campaigned for school improvements in Llandaff North, with two brand new schools built on their joint site.
- **Parks:** Improvement to the three tennis courts and further improvement for College Road Park and Lydstep Park.
- **LED Lights:** Expanded the roll-out of LED streetlights, with 14,000 installed on main highways, and an ongoing programme to install 23,000 in residential streets across Cardiff. These lights are better for the environment, easier to maintain and saves the Council hundreds of thousands in electricity bills.
- **Carriageway Resurface:** Continued to improve damaged carriageway in Pommergelli Road, Lydstep Crescent, Mynachdy Road, Cathedral View, Gabalfa Avenue, Hawthorn Road West, Hazelhurst Road, Radyr Road, Ty Mawr Road, Hawthorn Road West, Watson Road and Blossie Road. Further roads are included, College Road and Aberdulias Cresent.
- **Pavement Damaged by Tree Roots:** Continued to improve damaged pavements by tree roots in Gabalfa Avenue, Western Drive, Festiniog Road, Lydstep Crescent, Aberporth Road, Aberdulais Road, Colwinstone Street, Mynachdy Road and many more.
- **Footway Surface Treatment:** Footway resurface work to commence in the next programme for in Hawthorn Rd West, Ty Mawr Road, Evansfield Road, West Road, Pommergelli Road, Radyr Road, Hazlehurst Road and Belle Vue Road.
- **20mph:** Progressed our plans to make 20 mph the default speed in residential areas of Llandaff North and with the measure now applied to huge swathes of Cardiff North.
- **Councillors Community Award:** To recognise special contributions of people of Llandaff North.

Llwyddiannau dros y 5 mlynedd diwethaf:

- **Fflatiau Lydstep, Bloc 1, 2 a 3:** Mae gwaith gorcladio wedi dechrau yn Fflatiau Lydstep. Bydd y prosiect yn gweld gosod y cladin gradd A1 newydd; mae'r cladin hwn o'r lefel uchaf o ddiogelwch tân. Bydd ffenestri newydd, uwchraddio balconiau gan gynnwys balustradau, wynebaw a drws balconi newydd hefyd yn cael eu gosod. Bydd pob eiddo hefyd yn elwa o system awyru echdynnu newydd ar gyfer y gegin, yr ystafell ymolchi a gosod ffliw newydd ar y boeler.
- **Ysgol Glan Ceubal ac Ysgol Gynradd Gabalfa:** Ymgrychu dros wella ysgolion yn Ystum Taf, gyda dwy ysgol newydd sbon wedi'u hadeiladu ar eu cyd-safle.
Parciau: Gwelliant i'r tri chwrt tennis a gwelliant pellach ar gyfer Parc Ffordd y Coleg a Pharc Lydstep.
- **Goleuadau LED:** Ehangu'r broses o gyflwyno goleuadau stryd LED, gyda 14,000 wedi'u gosod ar briffyrdd, a rhaglen barhaus i osod 23,000 mewn strydoedd preswyl ledled Caerdydd. Mae'r goleuadau hyn yn well i'r amgylchedd, yn haws i'w cynnal ac yn arbed cannoedd o filoedd o filiau trydan i'r Cyngor.
- **Ailwynebu'r Ffordd Gerbyd:** Parhau i wella'r ffordd gerbydau a ddifrodwyd yn Pommergelli Road, Lydstep Crescent, Heol Mynachdy, Cathedral View, Gabalfa Avenue, Hawthorn Road West, Hazelhurst Road, Radur Road, Tŷ Mawr Road, Hawthorn Road West, Watson Road a Blossie Road. Cynhwysir ffyrdd pellach, Ffordd y Coleg a Chilgant Aberdulias.
- **Palmant wedi'i Ddifrodi gan Wreiddiau Coed:** Parhau i wella'r palmentydd a ddifrodwyd gan wreiddiau coed yn Gabalfa Avenue, Western Drive, Heol Ffestiniog, Lydstep Crescent, Heol Aberporth, Heol Aberdulais, Stryd Colwinstone, Heol Mynachdy a llawer mwy.
- **Triniaeth Wyneb y Droedffordd:** Gwaith ailwynebu'r llwybr troed i ddechrau yn y rhaglen nesaf ar gyfer Hawthorn Rd West, Tŷ Mawr Road, Evansfield Road, West Road, Pommergelli Road, Radur Road, Hazlehurst Road a Belle Vue Road.
- **20mya:** Symudwyd ymlaen â'n cynlluniau i wneud 20 mya y cyflymder diofyn yn ardaloedd preswyl Ystum Taf a chydaf'r mesur bellach yn berthnasol i rannau helaeth o Ogledd Caerdydd.
- **Gwobr Gymunedol y Cyngorwyr:** I gydnabod cyfraniadau arbennig pobl Ystum Taf.

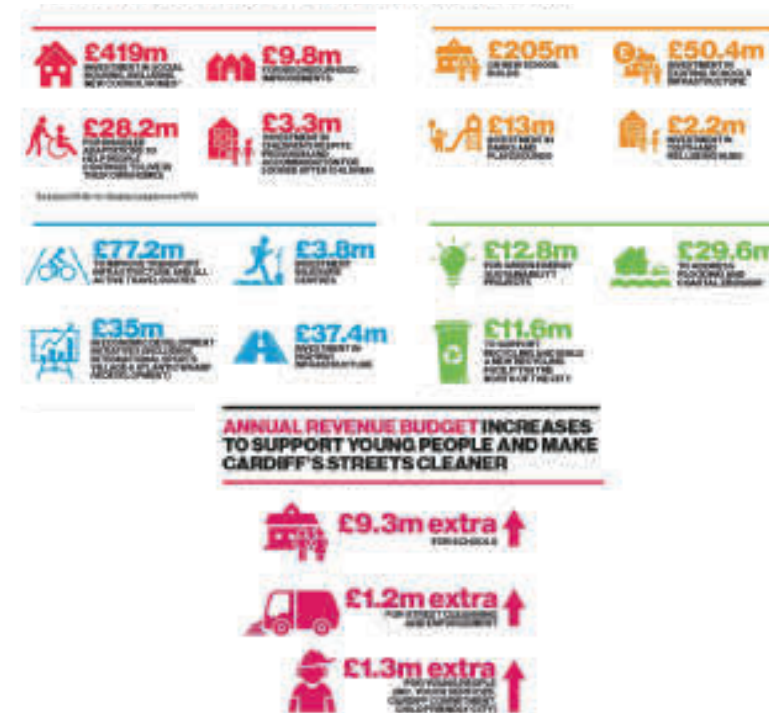

Cardiff's Labour budget to tackle the cost of living crisis

A budget designed to create new jobs, build new council homes, and improve opportunities for children and young people, while protecting the least well off as the 'cost-of-living crisis' takes hold. The Labour Group passes the Budget proposals, Cardiff's schools would receive an extra £9.3m; adults and children's services an extra £23.9m; and youth services and spending on young people an extra £2.4m. Council Tax would be set well below inflation at 1.9% - which is just 48p a week for a Band D household - down from last year's 3.5% increase. Among the proposals are significant spending plans to help Cardiff recover over the next five years, including:

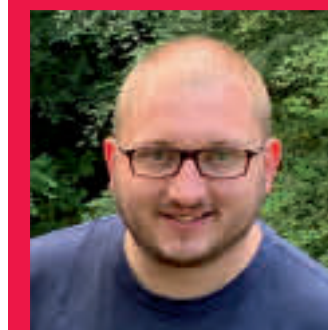
